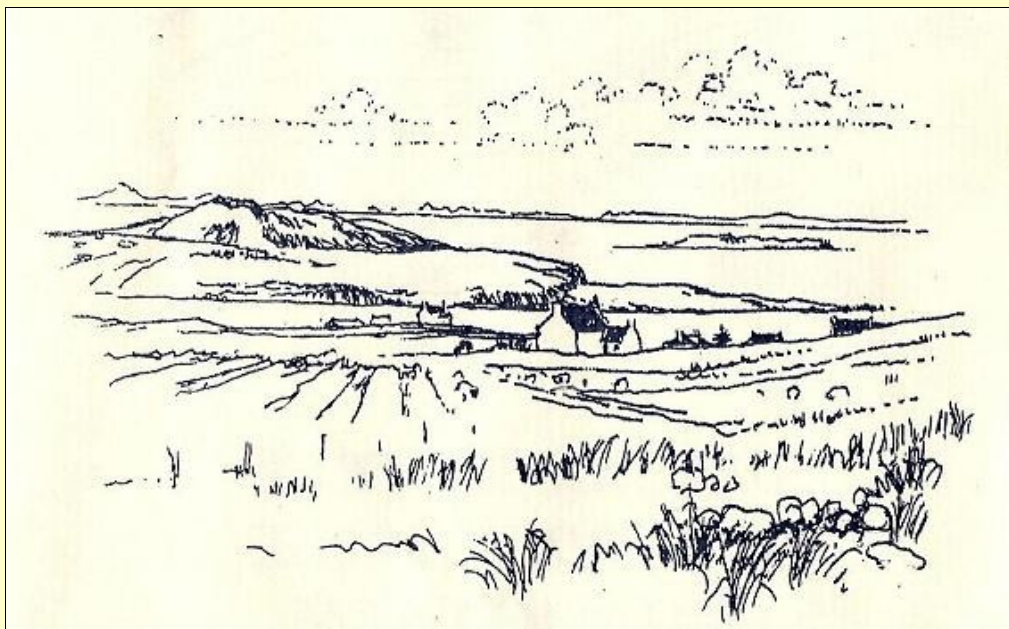


HOLY TRINITY TRUST
OLD CROFT HOUSE
BALMACQUIEN
ISLE OF SKYE

The Community of the Holy Trinity Trust offers the Old Croft House at Balmacquien, Isle of Skye as a quiet, prayerful place for those seeking a retreat, holiday or just their own space.

The invitation is ecumenical.



The house is set in two acres of land and overlooks the Sea with views across to the Outer Hebrides and has at its back the northernmost hills of the Trotternish Ridge. There is ample opportunity for walking, creativity or just 'being'. There are no shops nearby but from the main road half a mile away there is a bus service to Staffin, 5 miles, or Portree, 25 miles.



The accommodation comprises: upstairs, two bedrooms with two single beds in each; downstairs, a small shower, hand basin and w.c.; a kitchen/living room with an electric cooker, sink and oil-fired central heating boiler.

Within the house there is a Chapel which can be used for prayer and reflection.

The Old Croft is a non-smoking house.

Suggested donation is £110 per week.

Electricity is charged at cost. Concessions are available for members of religious communities and others if needed.
